## The CAC has been given approval to start a new Ad Hoc Committee on cyberbullying.

A peer can easily destroy another student's self-esteem, reputation, and safety in the far-reaching platform of cyberspace.

In January 2009 an Illinois law on cyberbullying went into effect, which puts the onus on school districts to properly monitor and handle instances of cyberbullying. (SB2426\*)

Think elementary students are too young? Check out Facebook to see which of your child's friends have Facebook accounts, you will be surprised!

The Cyberbullying Ad Hoc Committee will partner with administration to develop policy and procedures that specifically address cyberbullying. To help tackle this important topic, the committee would:

- Research cyberbullying resources online, what other districts are doing, what our individual schools are doing.
- Develop a comprehensive definition of cyberbullying (media, FB, My Space, texting, emails); the use of media to bully.
- Review the current district policy of bullying and make a recommendation on the expansion/reworking of it to specifically address cyberbullying. This would be a district-wide policy that would address: definition, reporting procedure, discipline, education and support resources.
- Help develop an education component for students, staff, and families.

The impact of this work would be experienced within the next school year and the positive impact would be felt for years to come.
